

Playday Shoot Out Procedures

1. The SMGA board of directors contributes \$1100 annually to the Playday shoot out. The intended purpose is to increase participation in the weekly playdays and reward those who do participate.
2. After the last scheduled Playday in October the top 25 money winners for the previous year and the top 25 participants are eligible to participate in the shoot out.
3. In order to participate you must sign up for the scheduled Wednesday Playday. (2023 date is 11/15. All ties for 25th place will also be eligible.
4. At the conclusion of Wednesday's Playday the low 10 net scores and ties for that day, will then be invited to the shootout on the next day. The time will be determined by the pro, but normally starts in the early afternoon. In the event a participant cannot not play his spot will be given to the next eligible person/ties.
5. During the shoot out all eligible players will tee off on the first hole. The lowest nine net scores will advance to hole two and so on. In the event of a tie for last advancing position, a chip off will be held from a location determined by the pro.
6. The final four surviving players will receive cash prizes. The top prize is \$500.
